

THE CHAP LADY Measurement Chart

Using a snug but not tight measuring tape:

- ____ 1. Chap waist directly below belt.
- ____ 2. Upper thigh: at crotch, taken **around** thigh & under buttocks
- ____ 3. Middle thigh: **around** ½ way between the distance of the upper thigh and knee.
- ____ 4. Knee **around** knee cap
- ____ 5. Calf taken **around** largest part of calf
- ____ 6. Outseam: directly below belt to floor, keeping tape close to body
- ____ 7. Inseam: **length** from crotch to floor with boots on, keeping tape close to body
- ____ 8. **Length** from crotch to center of knee cap
- ____ 9. **Length** from crotch to middle thigh (1/2 way between crotch and knee)
- ____ 10. **Length** from crotch to largest part of calf
- ____ 11. Rear rise: just below belt to where buttocks end and thigh begins
- ____ 12. Front rise: just below belt to crotch
- ____ 13. Waist: thru belt loops of pants being worn under chaps
- ____ 14. Lower waist: 3" below measurement #1 (for solid back chaps)

Helpful hints: a. Have someone measure for you.

b. Mark your clothing either with tape or chalk so your circumference and vertical measurements are accurate.

c. Measure with same type boots and pants that will be under chaps as lace up boots and pull on boots have different measurements as do jeans (especially low rise) and horsemanship pants.
